Jason Gunn is the founder and CEO of Oliver's Real Foods. Starting with a single store in Wyong in 2005 Jason has built his chain to 19 outlets along the east coast and is about to expand across Western Victoria and into South Australia. Oliver's stores provide organic real food alternatives in direct competition (and usually immediate proximity) to the more regular fast food outlets that we see on our major highways. He also famously asks the question... "Would you like beans with that?"

Dr Cathie Harvey is a qualified registered veterinarian and natural vet who has been practising for over 30 years in both companion and farm animals. She is also a Dairy Farmer herself with a property in Narrung SA. She uses veterinary homeopathy as her main natural treatment and is the only fully qualified veterinary homeopath in South Australia. She consults to organic farms and small animal clients who want natural treatment modalities for their animals.

Dr Peter Crisp is a Senior Entomologist at the South Australian Research and Development Institute. He has developed options for control of powdery mildew in Organic vineyards and also control of Kelly's citrus thrips using composted green waste, suitable for Organic citrus producers. He investigated the benefits of soil amendments to growers including increased populations of beneficial arthropods, greater water use efficiency and improved yield and fruit size.

Dr Ash Martin is a soil scientist, microbiologist and the principle of Microbiology Laboratories Australia - providing world-class commercial microbiology analyses for agriculture, forestry and the environment. It is a subsidiary of Creation Innovation Agriculture and Forestry, formed in 2007, with the aim of empowering farmers, agronomists, natural resource managers, fertiliser manufacturers and Government to make informed decisions about the use and management of micro-organisms.

Terril Marais is an entomologist with post graduate experience in applied IPM in Protected Crops. She worked as the IPM advisory officer for the Fresh Tomato Sector in NZ and consulted for greenhouse crops such as tomatoes, capsicums, eggplants, cucumbers, cymbidium orchids, roses, ornamentals, and outdoor crops such as strawberry mother production and hops. Terril ran her own biological control production company before joining Biological Services in 2013.
